“Life on the front line; more challenging than ever!”

Thanks to YOUR response from our latest appeal you have and are continuing to support more than 1,000 of the poorest families in



remote villages of Moldova. Samantha and Leo Sandu are active on the front-line delivering food parcels but also delivering hope through praying for people and offering communion. There have been many tears as the lost and abandoned have found comfort, light and hope through their love and prayers.

As Covid 19 proves the challenge of the decade, Moldovans who have already survived famine and, poverty in the nineties and noughties are now once again plunged into great devastation.

The lockdown will last from March 1st till at least June 15th when the countries plight will be reviewed.

“High level soldiering is not just about making war, but also involves building peace and following Jesus”.

Involved in the initial planning for military operations in Iraq in Sep/Oct '02, he deployed to Washington in Jan '03, and then Kuwait and Baghdad as the UK Deputy to the US-led Coalition Provisional Authority (CPA). In Jul '03 he returned to the UK, subsequently commanding the largest of the 3 Divisions of the UK Field Army, retiring in Jan '07. He was then the Army Adviser to the UK House of Commons Defence Committee for 7 years.

As a part of a broad portfolio, Tim is a Local Lay Minister in the Church of England and an itinerant preacher/speaker; he is engaged across the business, academic, charity and humanitarian world. A Tutor at the Leadership Trust, he sits on the Board of 4 UK/International companies and is a Visiting/Honorary Professor at two UK Universities.

Thank you so much for all that you are doing to bring sunshine and hope to a hopeless nation!


